Read what Northern Virginia Republican leaders have to say about Howie Lind and his campaign for 10th Congressional District Chairman

Virginia’s new Attorney General, Fairfax County resident and former State Senator, **Ken Cuccinelli** has known and worked with Lind for nearly 10 years. “Howie is a ‘can do’ conservative,” states Attorney General Cuccinelli. “Howie’s long experience and hard work will serve 10th District Republicans well,” he added, “but, looking over his extensive proposals for moving the 10th forward, you know you’ve got yourself a leader for the future.”

Hundreds of other Republican leaders, who have endorsed Lind, agree with Attorney General Cuccinelli. **Greg Stone**, Potomac District Chair of the Loudoun County Republican Party wrote in endorsing Lind, “Your goals and aspirations for the 10th District and the Republican Party of Virginia are spot on, positive, and were well received by many...[at a recent speech].

Other Republican leaders, who have worked shoulder to shoulder with Lind, know that he can implement the “goals and aspirations” that Greg Stone wrote about. **Charles Proctor**, Dranesville District Chairman of the Fairfax County Republican Committee, worked with him when Lind was the Dranesville Chairman. “Heading into the 2008 elections,” stated Charles, “there was a lot of nervousness about the McLean vote. Howie, single-handedly found office space, raised over \$30,000, recruited personnel, and opened a District office in McLean.” Charles noted that the grand opening of the office drew nearly 150 volunteers, hosted by Congressman Frank Wolf, and other candidates. “Howie,” said Charles, “had the energy, motivation and vision to put McLean back into fighting form, and it paid off in 2008 – and it carried over into the 2009 election cycle.”

Jim Hyland, former Chairman of the Fairfax County Republican Committee, agreed. “I’ve worked with Howie for a number of years. In 2008, on his own initiative as Dranesville Chairman, Howie opened and financed a satellite office for the Fairfax GOP in the heart of McLean.” Jim noted that the office “..generated hundreds of volunteers, thousands of phone calls and literature drops for all of our candidates in a swing area. I know he’ll show that type of leadership as Chairman of the 10th District.”

Kay Gunter, from Clarke County, is an elected 10th District State Central Committee member, as is Lind, and sits on the current 10th District Executive Committee, also along with Lind. “Howie is such a hard worker. He’s open, fair and more than anything, he wants to elect conservatives to office,” stated Kay. “He’s passionate – and he has real experience in organizing and working with grassroots Republicans at the precinct level.”

Both **Jim Hyland** and **Charles Proctor** agreed. “Howie is responsible for finding and recruiting quality candidates like **Barbara Comstock**, our new delegate in the 34th [District],” recalled Jim. “This year,” Charles noted, “Howie and I have already found three candidates that we are positioning for local and state office. It’s exciting.”

David Ray, from Fairfax County and the 11th Congressional District, is an elected member of the State Central Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and serves on that body with Lind. “Howie is a solid pro-life, pro-Constitution conservative,” said David. “He’s principled. He’s a straight shooter. Howie is interested in getting Republicans elected. He understands that to do that we have to pay attention to our base – we have to keep plugged into those groups that may not always be showing up at County meetings, but will vote with us if we give them a reason, a candidate, and we don’t ignore them.”

Greg Stone agrees, writing in his endorsement, “We need conservative leaders [like you] willing and eager to reach out to the Tea Party and independent conservative movements in order to build a coalition large enough to both win elections and fundamentally reform our government.”
